Acts 2:1 Fifty days after the Passover Feast. It is a Sunday morning in Jerusalem.

Acts 2:14 Peter, the apostle

The Message:

Acts 2:22-24 Jesus crucified and resurrected

Acts 2:25-35 The prophet's proof it was Jesus

Acts 2:41 3000 obeyed the Gospel in baptism

The Result

Acts 2:47 They were being saved.

Acts 2:47 The Lord added to the church daily. All who believed [saved] were together [stayed together] (v 44).
